

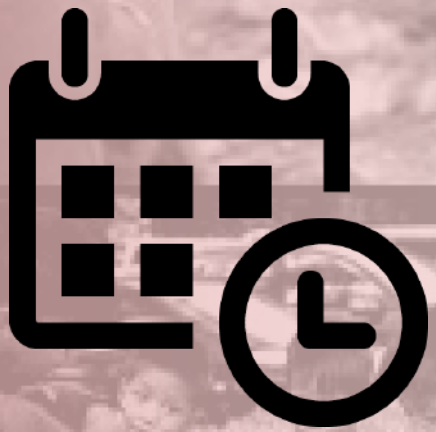

ABOUT THE E- SYMPOSIUM

According to the Census 2011, there were 472 million children in India under the age of 18 years, which constituted 39% of the total population in the country. India has the largest child population in the world. As per Save the Children's estimation, around 2 million children live on the streets of India, away from opportunities for learning and access to healthcare, but it is difficult to find out the exact figure of children on the street as there is evidence of children moving to the streets on large scale daily. They don't have a permanent shelter and they keep moving. The street children are also often described as 'hidden' or 'invisible' due to lack of identity, recognition, or social status that can make them count, these make them vulnerable to abuses and victimizations as well as getting indulged into delinquencies.
